The program is offered to **rising 9th graders who reside in North Augusta**. JLA is conducted during the month of July and will consist of an orientation, nine full day sessions, and a graduation ceremony. *Public, private, charter and home school students may apply.*

Expectations:

- Orientation is a mandatory evening event for parents and students. (Location TBA)
- Active participation in the Class Project discussion and event(s).
- Attendance at all sessions is expected. Only ONE absence is allowed and MUST be approved in advance.

Program Objectives:

- Encourage students to recognize and develop the skills needed for leadership potential.
- Provide opportunities for a diverse group of students to interact with one another and with community leaders and decision makers.
- Acquaint students with community needs, resources and other aspects of the greater North Augusta area.
- Introduce students to emerging career opportunities by working with a variety of professionals. Students will discover what it takes to reach their goals and acquire some of the skills needed to get there.
- Foster students' interest in volunteer community service.

Program fee is \$50 and will be collected upon acceptance to the program.
